Goal:

Provide Nurse Graduates with an orientation that fosters a supportive transition from novice Nurse Graduate to an engaged, competent nurse.

Objectives:

Develop effective decision-making skills through clinical reasoning related to clinical judgment Provide clinical leadership at the point of patient care

Formulate a personal professional development plan

ELIGIBILITY



A graduate of an accredited nursing program (ADN or BSN)

Apply to Nurse Resident position online

Provide two letters of recommendation

Eligible to take the NCLEX

Prior to start must have passed NCLEX and have RN license

PHASES 1-3



2-week classroom orientation



Two 3-week rotations through 2 units



Paired with preceptor for department specific orientation

PHASES 4-6



Additional department specific cohort training



Monthly roundtables focused on support, education and professional development
