Scotland Memorial Foundation Scholarships:

W.R. Dulin Memorial Scholarship - \$2,000

- Merit Based Scholarship
- Amount: \$2,000 (Payable to the institution of higher education)
- Scotland High School Senior
- Achieved at least a 3.0 GPA
- Accepted into an institution where he/she plans to enter a health care related course of study

Scotland Memorial Foundation Scholarship - \$2,000

(2 will be awarded)

- One merit based scholarship and one merit and need-based scholarship will be awarded
- Amount: \$2,000 (Payable to the institution of higher education)
- Achieved at least a 3.0 GPA
- Must reside in SHCS Service Area* or be the Dependent Child of a SHCS Associate
- Accepted into an institution where he/she plans to enter a health care related course of study

Scotland Memorial Foundation Community Service Scholarship- \$2,000

- Community Service Based Scholarship
- Amount: \$2,000 (Payable to the institution of higher education)
- Demonstrated a Commitment to Community Service
- Must reside in SHCS Service Area* or be the Dependent Child of a SHCS Associate
- Achieved at least a 3.0 GPA
- Accepted into an institution where he/she plans to enter a health care related course of study

Scotland Memorial Foundation Allied Health/Nursing Scholarship- \$1,000

(4 will be awarded)

- Merit & Need Based Scholarship
- Amount: \$1,000 each (4 scholarships are available - Payable to the institution of higher education)
- Must reside in SHCS Service Area* or be the Dependent Child of a SHCS Associate
- Achieved at least a 3.0 GPA
- Must express a need for financial assistance
- Accepted into an institution where he/she plans to enter an Allied Health or Nursing Program
- Emphasis given to students attending Richmond Community College

Scotland Health Care System Auxiliary Scholarships:

The Joyce Smith Scholarship & Ruth Bisbee Scholarship

(2 will be awarded)

- Service Based Scholarship
- Amount: \$1,500 each
- High School Senior
- Accepted into an institution where he/she plans to enter a health care related course of study
- Qualified applicants must have served at least 100 hours of volunteer service at Scotland Health Care System
